**TUITION INFORMATION:**

- \* \$725.00 per course. CCPS pays the reimbursement directly to the College of Notre Dame of Maryland, if you are eligible.
- \*\* \$1050.00 per course. Pay tuition and get reimbursed through Cecil County.
- \*\*\* \$1405.00 per course. Pay tuition and get reimbursed through Cecil County.

You may register in one of three ways. 1) **MAIL** – Obtain registration form from the College website, [www.ndm.edu](http://www.ndm.edu). Pull down menu for ACADEMICS. Go to REGISTRAR. Click on forms on right side of the page. Print the registration form and verification of education co-pay eligibility form. Have the verification form signed by the Human Resources Department. Complete both forms and mail to: Registrar’s Office, College of Notre Dame of Maryland, 4701 North Charles Street, Baltimore, MD 21210. Remember to include the \$100 registration fee. **DO NOT SEND CASH.** 2) **FAX** – See above instructions to obtain forms. Fax forms to the Registrar’s Office, 410-532-5789. There is a section on the registration form to pay the fee by credit card. 3) **In-person** – Visit the Registrar’s Office on the first floor of Gibbons Hall at the main campus in Baltimore, MD.

For acceptance into a degree or certification program you must complete an application process. For an admissions application please contact S. **TUITION INFORMATION:** **McDaniel Courses in Cecil County are available to CCPS employees who have enrolled into a specific Cohort program. New cohort groups are formed each year. If you DO NOT complete and receive approval through the Verification of Eligibility form, you will be billed directly by the college.** CCPS pays the reimbursement directly to McDaniel College if you are eligible. Off-campus students may register in one of four ways: 1) **College website** ([www.mcdaniel.edu](http://www.mcdaniel.edu)) – Click on “Login” at top of Home Page – Select “The Archway”—Provide your “Login” information – Proceed to “Student Menu”. This option is only available to Current McDaniel Students with an active McDaniel email account. 2) **Mail** – Obtain registration form from college website – Follow instructions above to “For Students” and proceed to “Graduate Forms”. Print the registration form, complete and mail to: Registrar’s Office, McDaniel College, 2 College Hill, Westminster, MD 21157. 3) **Fax** – Complete registration form and fax to: Registrar’s Office – 410-857-2752. 4) **In-person** – Visit the Registrar’s Office at the main campus of the college in Westminster, MD. \*Note –New students (degree seeking or non-degree seeking) will be required to submit an Application for Graduate Study (with one-time \$50.00 fee) before a course registration can be processed.
